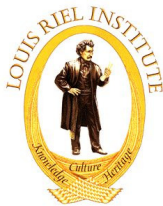


Philippe Martin Teillet. (b. 1950)

Metis scientist Philippe Teillet is the son of Roger Teillet (M.L.A., M.P., P.C. [1912-2002]). Philippe is a Professor, Department of Physics and Astronomy, University of Lethbridge and Senior Research Scientist, Alberta Terrestrial Imaging Centre.

He holds a B.Sc. from the University of Ottawa and M.Sc. and Ph.D. from the University of Toronto Department of Astronomy and Astrophysics. His 1977 dissertation was entitled "Differential Rotation and Meridional Circulation in Stellar Atmospheres." At the 23rd Canadian Remote Sensing Symposium Dr. Teillet was awarded "Best Symposium Paper," for "A Lifetime Radiometric Calibration Record for Landsat Thematic Mapper."
